

There are four domains in Dance: Creating (Domain 1), Performing (Domain 2), Responding (Domain 3), and Connecting (Domain 4). The domains correlate to the Artistic Processes and Anchor Standards in the National Core Arts Standards and the California Arts Content Standards. The CSET groups the domains as follows: Subtest I: Creating, Performing, Responding, and Connecting; Subtest II: Creating, Performing, Responding, and Connecting. This table is used to determine where candidates meet subject matter via coursework.
