Program Description

M.A. in Educational Administration

Students in this program will be earning an M.A. with the option of also earning a preliminary administrative services credential. Prospective students will submit two applications<sup>2</sup> one to the university and one to the program<sup>2</sup> by posted deadlines. Both applications should be submitted at the same time. All university regulations governing the master's degree apply to college programs. Program requirements published in the University Catalog in effect during the year a student begins the program are the requirements the student will be held to (catalog rights).

### Classified Admission

Successful applicants are admitted to the program with Classified Admission status.

#### Advancement to Candidacy - Clear Admission

Students should advance to candidacy as early as possible. For advancement to candidacy (Clear Admission status), students must:

1. Fulfill the campus Graduation Writing Assessment Requirement (GWAR).
2. Complete EDAD 636 and one other EDAD course for a total of 6 units.
3. Resolve all incomplete grades.
4. Maintain a 3.0 grade point average.
5. Submit to the Graduate Studies Office an Advancement to Candidacy form signed by the program coordinator.

Prerequisite(s) Admission to the Educational Administration Program or consent of instructor.

EDAD 621D (1 unit) Seminar: Preparing for Educational Leadership Positions

Prerequisite(s): Admission to the Educational Administration Program or consent of instructor.

EDAD 623 (2 units) Legal Aspects of Education

Prerequisite(s): Admission to the Educational Administration Program or consent of instructor.

EDAD 625 (2 units) Leadership, Organizational Management, and Social Justice

Prerequisite(s): Admission to the Educational Administration Program or consent of instructor.



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
